BRANSON, MO – So, maybe you weren't born in the 1880's. But that doesn't mean you can't enjoy the great fun of an era gone by. #### Rides of All Kinds

- **Wildfire**, a multi-looping cobra roller coaster that reaches speeds up to 66 MPH and includes 5 inversions and a 15 story vertical drop.
- Thunderation sends you on a runaway adventure through the treetops.
- American Plunge, a log ride that ends in a 5-story splashdown.
- BuzzSaw Falls, known as the "wildest ride in the woods," and is the first wet/dry roller coaster of its kind in the world.
- Fire-In-The-Hole, ventures you through a town set ablaze by the Baldknobbers.
- Frisco Silver Dollar Line Steam Train pleasures you with a scenic ride that brings you a wonderful touch
  of the Ozarks.
- Lost River of the Ozarks brings the best of the rapids to the whitewater rafting enthusiast.
- Wilderness Waterboggan where getting wet is everything (and staying dry is impossible!).

#### **Attractions**

- **Geyser Gulch**, a whopping 3-story climb into the world's largest tree house, complete with swinging bridges, towers, and erupting geysers.
- Grandfather's Mansion is like no one you've ever seen with weird tricks, zany antics and surprises!
- Marvel Cave where you can explore the natural wonder of this registered national landmark discovered in the 1550's.
- Splash Harbor, where you can cool off with the water cannons, aqua exploders, water blasters and more.
- Wilderness Church for your quieter side where hymn singing, vow renewal, and Sunday morning services take place in an authentic log cabin church.

- Cajun Connection takes you back to the Bayou with a combination of Cajun, Zydeco, country, and rock-n-roll music.

- Cumberland Quartet has been recognized for over 16 years as the resident gospel quartet for Opryland theme park in Nashville, Tennessee, as well as their appearances on Hee Haw, Nashville Now, Crook and Chase, Prime Time Country, and The Grand Ole Opry.
- Showdown at the Silver Dollar brings high-kicking Saloon girls, top-notch musicians, laughter and jokes to this "good-over-evil" sage.
- Championship Cloggers who bring their youthful exuberance to Silver Dollar City during the "National Kids Festival," with performances that demonstrate the origins and evolution of the clogging art form.
- For The Glory is the most elaborate show in Silver Dollar City's 40-year history, bringing to life the history and heritage of the Ozarks. This Broadway-caliber musical centered around a real-life Ozark family challenged by the events leading up to the Civil War battle of Wilson's Creek.



## **Festival of American Music and Craftsmanship**

This fall event combines American music with the "granddaddy" all craft festivals. With the Ozark Mountains as the backdrop, witness master craftsmen as they demonstrate glassblowing, basket weaving, pottery, candy making, and many other cherished turn-of-the-century crafts, along with unique crafts from carving to coppersmithing. Plus, enjoy dozens of talented visiting musicians performing bluegrass, gospel, and country music.

In addition to his combination of animals, Kirby's show is also known for his signature illusion - the appearance of a 35' Bell Jet Ranger Helicopter in less than 4 seconds. This trick is recognized as the world's largest and fastest illusion.

In addition to his year-round show, Kirby also delivers a Christmas Spectacular that features the multi-talented entertainer, Jim Barber. Jim delights audiences with his special skills as a ventriloquist, comedian, singer and musician. His tremendous talent for voices is matched by his ability as a musician, playing the guitar, banjo and drums.

And if being an magician and entertainer were not enough, Kirby is also the founder of Branson's *White Tiger Foundation* – a local, not-for-profit organization, dedicated to providing people from all backgrounds with opportunities to improve their lives by helping them to build skills, develop character, enhance self esteem, promote leadership skills, and nurture values. In addition, Branson's White Tiger Foundation is dedicated to promoting community and global awareness of the plight of endangered species, specifically the White Bengal Tiger. Branson's White Tiger Foundation is also dedicated to providing and to assist in providing sanctuary or refuge to endangered species and other animals.
